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Terms and conditions

1. The applicants shall maintain good house keeping both within factory and in the premises. All hose pipelines valves, storage tanks etc. shall be leak proof. In plant allowable pollutants levels, if specified by State Board should be met strictly.
2. The applicant/company shall comply with and carry out directive/orders issued by the Board in this consent order at all subsequent times without negligence of his /its part. The applicant/company shall be liable for such legal action against him as per provision of the law/act in case of violation of any order/directives. Issued at any time and or non compliance of the terms and conditions of his consent order.
3. The applicant shall make an application for grant of consent at least 90 days before the date of expiry of this consent.
4. Necessary fee as prescribed for obtaining renewal consent shall be paid by the applicant alongwith the consent application.
5. If due to any technological improvement or otherwise this Board is of opinion that all or any of the conditions referred to above required variation (including the change of any control equipment either in whole or in part) this Board shall after giving the applicant an opportunity of being heard vary all or such condition and there upon the applicant shall be bound to comply with the conditions so varied.
6. The industry shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages, discharge of any pollutants gas/liquids from the vessels, mechanical equipment etc. which are likely to cause environment pollution.

7. The industry shall comply noise pollution (Regulation and control) Rules, 2000.
8. The industry shall comply all the direction/Rules/Instructions as may be issued by the MOEF/CPCB/HSPCB from time to time.
9. The industry shall ensure that various characteristics of the effluents remain within the tolerance limits as specified in EPA Standard and as amended from time to time and at no time the concentration of any characteristics should exceed these limits for discharge.
10. The industry would immediately submit the revised application to the Board in the event of any change in the raw material in process, mode of treatment/discharge of effluent. In case of change of process at any stage during the consent period, the industry shall submit fresh consent application alongwith the consent to operate fee, if found due, which may be on any account and that shall be paid by the industry and the industry would immediately submit the consent application to the Board in the event of any change during the year in the raw material, quantity, quality of the effluent, mode of discharge, treatment facilities etc.
11. The officer/official of the Board shall reserve the right to access for the inspection of the industry in connection with the various process and the treatment facilities. The consent to operate is subject to review by the Board at any time.
12. Permissible limits for any pollutants mentioned in the consent to operate order should not exceed the concentration permitted in the effluent by the Board.
13. The industry shall pay the balance fee, in case it is found due from the industry at any time later on.
14. If the industry fails to adhere to any of the conditions of this consent to operate order, the consent to operate so granted shall automatically lapse.
15. If the industry is closed temporarily at its own, they shall inform the Board and obtain permission before restart of the unit.
16. The industry shall comply all the Directions/ Rules/Instructions issued from time to time by the Board.
17. Industry should adopt water conservation measures to ensure minimum consumption of water in their process. Ground water based proposals of new industries should get clearance from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA)/ Haryana Water Resources (Conservation, Regulation and Management) Authority (HWRA) for scientific development of precious resource.
18. The industrial/non industrial sector projects shall develop green belt (as applicable) in its premises including periphery, entry and exit, as per notifications/conditions of EC/directions of MOEF/CPCB/SPCB/NGT/ any court of law. In case of stone crushers, hot mix plants, mineral grinding units, screening plants and brick kilns etc., the unit shall develop adequate green belt and erect barrier/barricade/boundary wall as applicable, as per notifications/directions of MOEF/CPCB/SPCB/NGT/ any court of law.
19. The unit shall develop paved or hard surfaced approach road to the site of unit (including the storage site, if it is at different place) from the nearest public road for transportation of raw material/final product.

Specific Conditions :

1. That the unit will run and maintain the ETP/APCM regularly.
2. That the unit will not made any expansion without prior permission of the Board.
3. That the unit will apply for renewal of CTO before 90 days from expiry of this CTO.
4. That the unit will not discharge any effluent outside its premise without prior approval of Board or without Permission from MC/PHED or

Concerned Dept. 5. That the CTO so granted would be revoked without any prior Notice if Unit fails to comply with any of the conditions of CTO. 6. That the unit will maintain the log book of STP installed by the unit. 7. That the Environmental compensation would be imposed as per policy of Board for Violation of CTO and Air/Water/EP Act conditions for environmental damage 8. That the unit will abide by the directions of CPCB/HSPCB/MOEF&CC and any other competent authority time to time. 9. That the unit will abide the directions/ orders of Hon'ble Supreme court /High Court/NGT/SEC any other court. 10. That concealing factual data or submission of false/ fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the condition mentioned above may result in withdrawal of this CTO and attract action under the provisions of Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 and violation of any law of land. 11. That the unit will submit the sample report within 03 months after the grant of CTO. 12. That the unit will abide by all the CAQM directions as issued from time to time. 13. That the unit will obtain authorization under HOWM rules 2016 within 30 days after the grant of CTO, if applicable. 14. That the CTO so granted shall become invalid in case of violation of any of the above / any law of the land. 15. That the unit will also obtain permission from Ground Water Authority, if applicable. 16. The unit shall ensure the compliance of provisions of Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules, 2022, including the Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR), as relevant for the project. 17.
